The Egremont PTO is an active parent organization that helps enrich both in school and out of school experiences for students, families and teachers. There are many committees with varying amounts of volunteer time. All families at Egremont are members of the Egremont PTO.

Fall Fundraiser- Help tally orders, distribute orders, and work with the company representative.

Box Tops and More- Help with Box Top counting, gift card fundraiser before the holidays, sort and pack ink and toner cartridges for recycling, help facilitate programs like Price Chopper Tools for Schools and Big Y Education Express, prepare Campbell's Label for Education, and seek out other ways companies can help our school earn money or supplies.

Fun Fair- Plan annual fun fair, which takes place in Late May/early June. Planning starts in March. The fun fair is an Egremont favorite. It is a night of fun, food, and games! We are also in need of parents to help run games and sell tickets and food.

School Store- Volunteers needed to work in school store, which takes place on Wednesdays during lunch for grades 1-5.

Spirit Wear- Help organize annual sale of school logo merchandise and distribute when it comes in.

Book Fair- Volunteers needed to help work at the book fair which takes place during November parent/teacher conferences. This year the dates will be November 12 and 13th.

PCTV- Learn to use PCTV equipment and help tape school activities and events to be aired on Pittsfield Community TV.

5th Grade- Plan end of year picnic for 5th graders and help with fundraising to fund special 5th grade field trip.

Yearbook- This is a committee of fifth grade parents who would like to plan, design, and fundraise for a 5th grade yearbook.

Special Events- This committee plans family events that take place about once a month. Volunteers are needed to either help with set up and planning or to help at the event. Some events in the past have been bingo night, Holiday night, school dances, and Halloween night.

RIF- Distributes books to all of the children twice a year. Event is usually from 8:45 until 11:30 and occurs on a half day.

Beautification- Help organize and work at ground/playground clean-up days.

Egremont Eagle- Work with children to produce a school newspaper which is distributed in the spring.

Spring Fundraiser- Help with orders and distribution of spring fundraiser.

Hospitality- Plans refreshments for 1st day of school, gives school tours, speaks at Sneak a Peek at K Day, and provides support for new families.

Talent Show- Schedule and organize talent show, tickets, programs, etc.

Teacher Appreciation- Organizes teacher breakfast and luncheon, and plans events for teacher appreciation week.

After-school activities- Help organize and facilitate activities or teach a program for a six week session one time per week.

Arts & Enrichment- Researches and schedules performances to come to the school for school-wide assemblies.

Digital Committee- A new committee formed to get an online presence of the PTO and to look into the feasibility of going "paperless."

Per Diem Sign-up- Is called when specific events or committees are ever in need of more volunteers.

Lunch and Recess Duty- Help one day a week in the cafeteria and/or the playground. New for 2009- all volunteers MUST sit in on a new training session (Time and date of training will be announced).
